Four age categories:

Ages 4-9 Ages 10-13
Ages 14-17 18 and above



Schedule:

- 9:30-10:00am Participants MUST sign-in at the Tri Kappa booth (corner of Pearl and Columbia)
- 10:00am Participants may start to create their Sidewalk Chalk Art Masterpieces
- 2:00pm Judging begins
- 3:30pm Awards at the grand stand

Participants:

- are required to complete and sign event forms (registration, liability waiver, media and press release)
- between ages 4 and 18 must have parent/guardian signature on all event forms
- must provide their own chalk
- may design and practice their chalk art on paper or sidewalk at home prior to the contest
- may use original sketches as a reference during the event (not reproductions)

Theme: *Aboard the Midnight Train*

Judging:

- is based on theme interpretation, craftsmanship, creativity, originality, skill and use of color
- is based on the opinions of a select group of recognized local artists
- decisions of the judges and organizers are final

Organizers:

- have the right to disqualify and/or remove any inappropriate art or writing, as they may deem necessary
- are not responsible for accidents, stolen objects, or damage to art work
- will take digital images of the top three artists and artwork in each category for a community birthday calendar and/or greeting cards published by Union City Psi Chapter of Tri Kappa
- will award winners with ribbons and two copies of published works
- have the right to modify or add to these rules, as necessary

Sidewalk Chalk Art Contest Rules:

- Art must be family-friendly; No nude or lewd artwork
- No use of commercial or personal stencils
- Only solid, non-toxic pastels (chalk) or sidewalk chalk can be used
- No political or commercial advertising statements are allowed
- 58" x 60" sidewalk/street blocks containing a white base coat will be assigned based on registration
- Participant is limited to one block; no group projects
- Sidewalk art must be completed between 10:00 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Wednesday, August 3. Rain date is Thursday, August 4.

Other considerations:

- dress comfortably and bring a towel or something to sit on while drawing on the sidewalk
- pack snacks or money for lunch
- family and friends may watch but will be asked to stand or sit away from the participants during the competition
